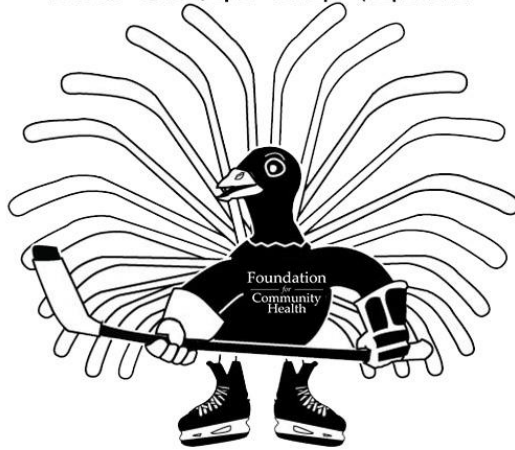

Registration form and \$200 non-refundable deposit due November 20.
The balance will be due before your team can step on the ice.

Information:

- Four-game guarantee for all teams
- Championship game for the top two teams, with prizes to the winners
- Games are three 16-minute run time periods, with a three-minute warm up.
- This is a no check, no slap shot tournament, and USA Adult Hockey rules apply.
- Games start at 11a.m. or noon Friday and are expected to conclude by 5 pm Sunday or earlier. Every effort will be made to accommodate out of town travel when arranging the schedule.
- Team make-up must follow Ty Robinson's Rules (see next page for description)

Community Cup Hockey Benefit Ty Robinson's Rules

The spirit of this tournament is FUN! Because of that, each team is only allowed two Cup/Advanced players who will be identified by colored tape on their helmets. The team must be comprised of:

- No more than **two** Cup/Advanced-level players
- Two Intermediate-level players
- Two Novice-level players
- Two women
- Two players over 50 years' old
- One medical/dental personnel (must be in health industry)
- Additional players can be a mix of levels as long as they aren't Cup/Advanced

A player can only fulfill one requirement – e.g., if the player is a Cup player and a doctor, he will only fulfill the Cup role and the team still needs a medical person. Cup/Advanced players will fulfill that role first – i.e., a female Advanced player fulfills the Cup/Advanced spot, not the woman requirement.

Each Cup player is only allowed to score once per game.

If a team is ahead by two points, the goalie must play without his/her stick

The blue puck can be called for by a team once a game. When the blue puck is in play, it is worth two points. Each team is allowed to call for the blue puck during a game stop. The puck stays in play for two minutes or until a score is made.

Penalties follow standard rules.

No slap shots.

All players must be 18 years of age or older and have a current USA Hockey number to participate in the tournament, no exceptions.
